



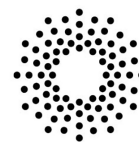

Accelerated study

Once candidates have completed the NCC Education Level 7 Diploma in Business Management (L7DBM) they are eligible to apply onto an accelerated study option directly with London Metropolitan University and be awarded an MSc in Information Technology via distance learning.

The MSc course is specifically designed for career enhancement. It aims to equip learners with important knowledge and skills highly valued by employers in the IT industry. These include mobile computing, information systems, advanced databases and project management.

Year 1

Enhance your business skills and accelerate your career into senior management by completing the Level 7 Diploma in Business Management (L7DBM) through online self-study. Candidates must study and pass six units; this includes two core units and four electives.

Core units

1. Information Systems and Knowledge Management
2. Project Management

Elective units (pick any 4)

1. Entrepreneurship and innovation
2. Digital Marketing and Communications
3. Strategic Management
4. Leadership, People and Change
5. International Marketing Strategy
6. Corporate Finance and Decision Making

Year 2

Successful L7DBM graduates can now progress onto the London Metropolitan University MSc in Information Technology with Accreditation of Prior Learning (APL). Students can top-up to a full MSc by taking the following modules via distance learning:

Mobile Application Design and Development	20
Database Systems with Professional Certification	20
MSc Project	60

Assessment

In year one, all L7DBM assessment is by coursework only

In year two, all assessment with London Metropolitan University is by coursework, with a built-in oral presentation/viva using the London Metropolitan University teleconference facility where appropriate.

Entry requirements

Year one

A BSc honours degree in Computing, Business Information Systems or similar from a UK university, or equivalent award from a non-UK university and a minimum of 3 years' relevant work experience

Year two with Accreditation of Prior Learning (APL)

Successful completion of the L7DBM (must include core units) and IELTS 6.0

Successful completion of this course offers a wide range of career opportunities in the Information Technology industry in private and public sectors.

- business or systems analysis
- IT consultancy, support services
- product management and training

Fees

The London Metropolitan University accelerated study fee for NCC Education students is £3,200.
